Problem

- You have a Scrum Alliance certification.
- It was good for 2 years.
- And it is about to, or has, expired.



Is It Good to Renew Your Certification(s)?

- *Yes!*



How Can You Renew Your Certification?

- Two ways:
 - Gather SEUs (e.g., 20 for a CSM)
 - Take a course



SEUs - 1

- It might be a bit complicated.
- SEUs, via the SEU calculator
- And then a fee (see the schedule), possibly via the calculator.
- Example: CSM, 20 SEUs, \$100



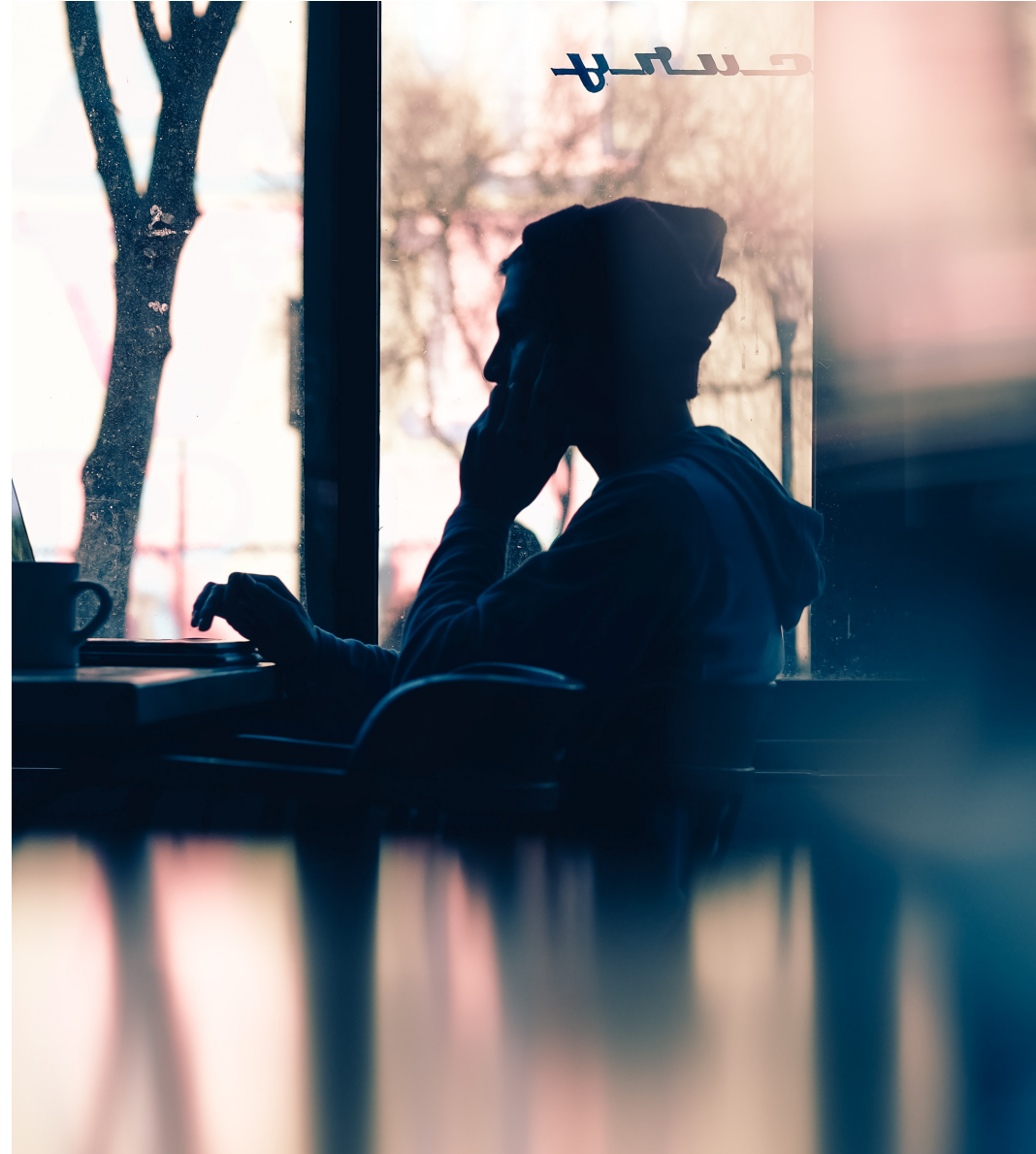
SEUs - 2

- About anything that gives you a learning hour.

Take a Course

- Any Scrum Alliance certification course
- Pay the Scrum Alliance fee (so that your course is uploaded to Scrum Alliance site)
- You do not have to take the CSM Test again



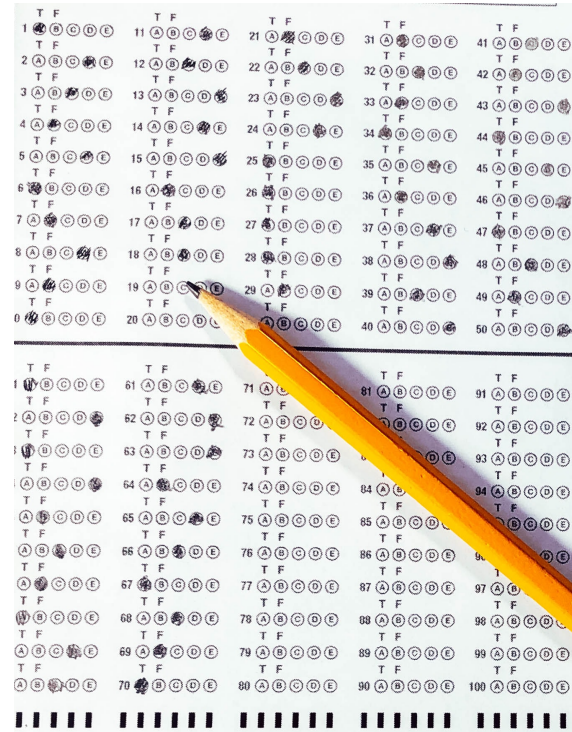
My Fees to Re-take a Course

- CSM, CSPO, Advanced-CSM
- Right now, for an online course, to re-take is \$100 per day...
- **Plus** the Scrum Alliance fee.
- So, to re-take a CSM = \$100 + \$100 + \$50 or a total of \$250.



Any Course...

- Take any course. It renews all your certificates for 2 years.



You Can Take a Course

- Example: You have the CSM.
- You could re-take the CSM... or....
- Take (new) a CSPO course or an A-CSM.
- With me, a new course will be more money, i.e., normal price.



Advantages

- Refreshes your knowledge
- Simpler
- Maybe a bit more money
- More convenience
